A machine operator was lifting a 100-pound steel beam when he experienced back pain. He reported the incident the same day and tried to return to work on the following day, but his back pain continued. Emergency back surgery was needed for a herniated disc. A second surgery removed remaining disc fragments. The employee was out of work 10 months. Medical bills, lost time and indemnity payments: more than \$250,000.
